A Federal Marketing Order was established in 1995, specifying the Walla Walla Valley as the only region authorized to grow the Walla Walla Sweet Onion. Walla Walla sweet onions have been hand-harvested for many generations and are planted in carefully selected soils in the Walla Walla Valley of Southeast Washington and Northeast Oregon.
